

Some Suggestions on Student Designs

1. Use white 8½” x 11” paper. The white will not print on the shirt.
2. Create the design in portrait – that is, long side up and down, since most designs on a shirt are arranged that way.
3. Make sure that the words “GO GREEN” are large enough to be dominant in the design.
4. Avoid straight line borders. Designs look better when they float on a shirt and not look like a rectangle.
5. Avoid light yellows and whites as these colors will not show up well on the natural color (light tan) of the shirt. Use a lot of blues, greens, browns, and earthy reds.
6. Somewhere in the design have the student place their 3 initials so their family can recognize their design on our site. We will not use student names. We suggest 3 initials to avoid overlap between 2 students with the same first and last initials. If they share 3 initials, they may have to use a number such as *abc1* and *abc2*.
