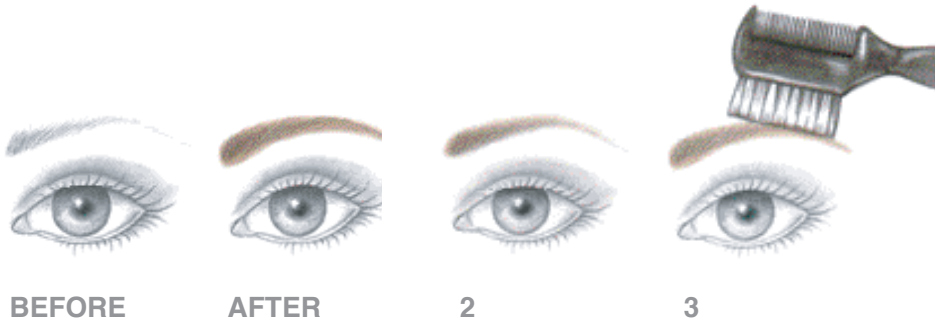


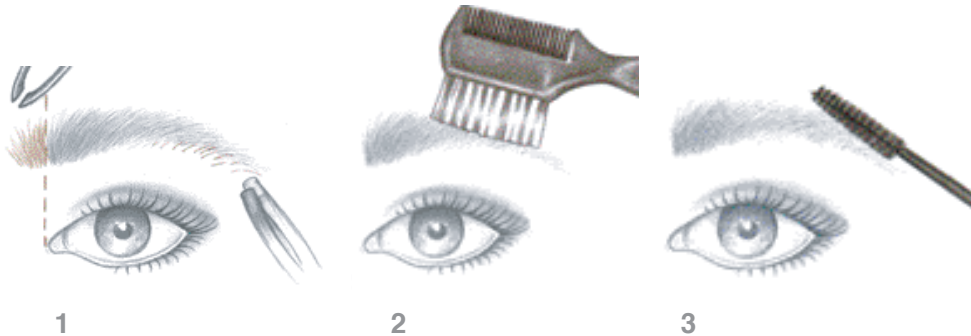
Eyebrows



To Thicken Thin Eyebrows

- Taupe Pencil is a universal shade that works with all skin tones.
- Eyebrow should begin parallel to inner corner of eye and end just beyond eye.
- Eyebrow is fullest at nose bridge, gently arches and softly tapers at end.
- 1. Start at nose bridge, use taupe pencil and roll color over eyebrow hair.
- 2. Deposit color again under eyebrow hairs, following natural shade.
- You can work under and slightly above natural hairs to thicken. It is o.k. You can do it! Your brows will not look too thick!
- 3. Blend with eyebrow groomer, brush up hairs.
- Spray eyebrow groomer with hairspray or apply damp soap, and brush through hairs to keep brows brushed up.
- Apply Brow Gel for a fresh look and to keep eyebrows swept up.

Full Eyebrows

Eyebrows are the frame for the eyes. Try not to change their natural shape.

- The beginning of the eyebrow should be in line with inner corner of the eye and end just beyond eye.
- 1. Tweeze hairs on nose bridge (if any).
- Remove only hairs which are obviously outside of the natural shape.
- When tweezing, remove a few hairs from one eye, then alternate to other brow. This eliminates over-tweezing and achieves a more balanced look.
- Using an Eyebrow Groomer, brush hairs up.
- If a few hairs are missing, draw in each hair with an Eyebrow Pencil using a light feather touch stroke. Begin at bottom and draw upward following hair direction.
- 2. To keep brow hairs swept up deposit damp soap on Eyebrow Groomer, or spray hairspray on eyebrow brush, and brush through eyebrows.
- 3. For a fresh look, coat eyebrows with Brow Gel.
- For more dramatic look, try coating brows lightly with black mascara.

To Thicken Sparse Eyebrows

- To strengthen the natural frame for eyes use taupe eyebrow pencil.
- Use natural brow shape as a guide.
- Beginning of eyebrow should be parallel with inner corner of eye and just beyond eye.
- 1. Using the taupe eyebrow pencil, draw in individual hairs between your natural hairs.
- Start each stroke from base drawing upward, following natural hair direction.
- Use a light-handed, hair fine stroke.
- 2. Roll pencil under eyebrow to deposit color on skin to thicken brow shape. Make sure you follow natural eyebrow shape.
- Brows should be fullest at nose bridge, gently arching and softly tapering at the ends.
- Using an Eyebrow Groomer, brush through brow with upward sweep.
- You can deposit damp soap on brush or spray it with hair spray, then brush through eyebrow again to keep hairs sweeping up.
- 3. For a fresh look, instead of soap or hair spray, coat eyebrow hairs and brush up with Brow Gel.
- If drama is your look, try coating eyebrow hairs lightly with black mascara.
